Powerful knowledge/skills for this unit:

We will learn about:

Where money comes from and making choices when spending money

- understand that people get money in different ways (earn, win, find, presents, pocket money, borrow, benefits)
- recognise that people make choices about what to buy
- understand that they may not always be able to have all the things they want

Saving money and how to keep it safe

- understand why people might want to save their money
- can say how it feels to save for something you really want
- recognise where money is stored to keep it safe and some places are safer than others

Different jobs people do

- know that there are a range of jobs that people can do
- recognise that both men and women are able to do a range of jobs
- understand that having a job means people can earn money

What should I already know:

Know about the lives of the people around them and their roles in society. (ELG EYFS)

Big Question:

How can you save money for something you would really like?

The end point: Understand why people might want to save their money. Know how can people keep their money safe.
