### Powerful knowledge/skills for this unit:

**Pupils learn about the risks associated with using different drugs, including tobacco and nicotine products, alcohol, solvents, medicines and other**

**legal and illegal drugs**

Pupils

- know about some of the possible effects and risks of different drugs
  - know that some drugs are restricted or that it is illegal to own, use and supply them to others
- understand why and when people might use drugs

**Pupils learn about assessing the level of risk in different situations involving drug use**

Pupils

- can explain why risk depends on the drug itself, the person using the drug and the situation – when and where the person is, and who they are with
- can identify risks within a given scenario involving drug use

understand what would need to change to reduce the level of risk

- can describe how the media portrayal might affect people's feelings about themselves

**Pupils learn about ways to manage risk in situations involving drug use**

Pupils

- can identify situations where drug use may occur
- know some ways of reducing risk in situations involving drug use

know where to get help, advice and support regarding drug use
